Leaven Your World

We have spent the thirty three days in reflection, discerning the ways in which we are called to be a more perfect mirror of the God in whose image our souls were fashioned. The fifty days after lent are for rejoicing! But it is not enough simply to rejoice. The knowledge of our salvation can and should spur us to action---a lesson learned by the Apostles, for whom news of the Resurrection was paired with a call to preach the Good News to all nations. This they did boldly, even when it cost them their lives. Here are a few ways to spread the Good news.

SEEK FORGIVENESS-The wonder of Christianity is the knowledge that no sin, no mistake, places us beyond redemption. God will forgive anything-even when human beings cannot. What regrets hold you prisoner, preventing you from fully loving family members and friends? The grace of the sacrament of reconciliation is not confined to the penitential seasons.

FORM YOUR CONSCIENCE-It is all too easy these days to focus on what separates "us" from "them". What guidance have our Popes and Bishops given us on issues like immigration, racial privilege, taxation, global stewardship, sexuality and health care? Take time to inform yourself on an issue that causes division among people of good faith. Seek to explore common ground in online and face-to-face conversations about these topics. Be open to the concerns held by people who hold opposing views and look for real solutions, not small sound or information bytes.

EXTEND A HAND-Many of us live our lives surrounded by people who look and think much as we do. Make a conscious effort to get to know someone whose background, skin color, native language, or religious beliefs are different than your own.

DO NOT BE AFRAID-There's a reason this exhortation fills the pages of scripture. Witnessing to our faith leaves us open to ridicule and rejection. We don't need to go door to door bearing pamphlets, but every day presents opportunities to speak a word of hope and encouragement, to advise, or to share experiences with individual members of our social circles. You never know when your witness will empower someone to change for the better or persevere in affliction.

LEAVEN YOUR WORLD WITH HOPE-No one can change the world alone, but the Resurrection gives us hope that each of us can indeed make a difference.

Evelyn Huron, director of Caritas Legal Services, says "kinship serves many benefits for the children because they have continuity of care, connection to their family, and creates a sense of stability. Pope Francis Lenten Reflections

HOLY THURSDAY: A Time to Help One Another-When Jesus washed the feet of his disciples on Holy Thursday, He was setting the example for us that we must do as He did for us. He is yet the most important, yet he washes feet, because with us what is highest must be at the service of others. Washing feet means: "I am at your service." That simply means that we must help one another. This is what Jesus teaches us and this is what we must do, with all our heart, because it is our duty. We must be of service. But it is a duty which comes from our heart. This is what the Lord taught us to do.

GOOD FRIDAY: A Time to Carry Our Cross-Good Friday is the culminating moment of love, The death of Jesus, who on the cross surrenders himself to the Father in order to offer salvation to the entire world, expressing love given to the end, a love without end. A love that seeks to embrace everyone, that excludes no one. The cross of Christ bears the suffering and the sins of all humanity, including our own. Jesus accepts all this with open arms, bearing on his shoulders our crosses and saying to us: "Have courage! You do not carry your cross alone! I carry it with you.

HOLY SATURDAY: A Time to Remember-Jesus laid in the tomb shares with all of humanity in the tragedy of death. But the women encounter the newness of God. Jesus has risen, he is alive! Faced with empty tomb and the two men in brilliant clothes, their first reaction is one of fear. But when they hear the message of the resurrection, they accept it in faith. This is the invitation to remember their encounter with Jesus, to remember his words, his actions, his life. To remember that God has done and continues to do for us, to remember the road we have travelled. This is what opens our hearts to hope for the future. May we learn to remember everything that God has done in our lives.

Levanta tu mundo

Hemos pasado los treinta y tres días en la reflexión, discerniendo las formas en que estamos llamados a ser un espejo más perfecto del Dios a cuya imagen se moldearon nuestras almas. ¡Los cincuenta días después de haber sido prestados son para regocijarse! Pero no es suficiente simplemente para regocijarse. El conocimiento de nuestra salvación puede y debe impulsarnos a la acción --- una lección aprendida por los Apóstoles, para quienes la noticia de la Resurrección se combinó con un llamado a predicar las Buenas Nuevas a todas las naciones. Esto lo hicieron audazmente, incluso cuando les costó la vida. Aquí hay algunas maneras de difundir las Buenas Nuevas.

BUSQUE EL PERDÓN-La maravilla del cristianismo es el conocimiento de que ningún pecado, ningún error, nos coloca más allá de la redención. Dios perdonará todo, incluso cuando los seres humanos no puedan. ¿Qué remordimientos te mantienen prisionero, impidiéndote amar plenamente a los miembros de la familia y a los amigos? La gracia del sacramento de la reconciliación no se limita a las estaciones penitenciales.

FORME SU CONCIENCIA: Hoy en día es muy fácil enfocarse en lo que nos separa de "ellos". ¿Qué orientación nos han dado nuestros Papas y Obispos en temas como inmigración, privilegio racial, impuestos, administración global, sexualidad y cuidado de la salud? Tómese el tiempo para informarse sobre un problema que causa división entre las personas de buena fe. Busque explorar puntos en común en conversaciones en línea y cara a cara sobre estos temas. Esté abierto a las inquietudes de las personas que tienen puntos de vista opuestos y busque soluciones reales, no pequeños bytes de sonido o información.

EXTENDER UNA MANO: muchos de nosotros vivimos nuestras vidas rodeados de personas que miran y piensan igual que nosotros. Haga un esfuerzo consciente para conocer a alguien cuyos antecedentes, color de piel, idioma nativo o creencias religiosas sean diferentes a las suyas.

NO TENGAS MIEDO. Hay una razón por la cual esta exhortación llena las páginas de las Escrituras. Dar testimonio de nuestra fe nos deja expuestos al ridículo y al rechazo. No necesitamos ir de puerta en puerta portando panfletos, pero todos los días presentamos oportunidades para hablar una palabra de esperanza y aliento, aconsejar o compartir experiencias con miembros individuales de nuestros círculos sociales. Nunca se sabe cuándo su testigo capacitará a alguien para cambiar para mejor o perseverar en la aflicción.

VEA SU MUNDO CON ESPERANZA: NINGUNO puede cambiar el mundo solo, pero la Resurrección nos da la esperanza de que cada uno de nosotros pueda hacer la diferencia.

But it is a duty which comes from our heart. This is what the Lord taught us to do.

GOOD FRIDAY: A Time to Carry Our Cross-Good Friday is the culminating moment of love, The death of Jesus, who on the cross surrenders himself to the Father in order to offer salvation to the entire world, expressing love given to the end, a love without end. A love that seeks to embrace everyone, that excludes no one. The cross of Christ bears the suffering and the sins of all humanity, including our own. Jesus accepts all this with open arms, bearing on his shoulders our crosses and saying to us: "Have courage! You do not carry your cross alone! I carry it with you.

HOLY SATURDAY: A Time to Remember-Jesus laid in the tomb shares with all of humanity in the tragedy of death. But the women encounter the newness of God. Jesus has risen, he is alive! Faced with empty tomb and the two men in brilliant clothes, their first reaction is one of fear. But when they hear the message of the resurrection, they accept it in faith. This is the invitation to remember their encounter with Jesus, to remember his words, his actions, his life. To remember that God has done and continues to do for us, to remember the road we have travelled. This is what opens our hearts to hope for the future. May we learn to remember everything that God has done in our lives.
